Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1967 COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA Prohibition of Entry into Safety Zone— Mullaway-1 Subsea Well

I, David Ronald White, Minister for Industry, Technology and Resources for the State of Victoria, the Designated Authority in respect of the area specified as being adjacent to the State of Victoria, under the provisions of section 119 of the Act hereby prohibit from entering into or remaining in, except with my consent in writing, the area of the safety zone described hereunder, all vessels other than vessels engaged in or in connection with petroleum exploration operations or operations for the recovery of petroleum authorised by me in the area concerned.

## Description of Area in Safety Zone

The area which extends to a distance of five hundred metres measured from a subsea well known as Mullaway-1 situated at or about Latitude 38 deg. 19 mins. 24-23 secs. South Longitude 147 deg. 29 mins. 10-02 sec. East and marked by means of a wellhead marker buoy described hereunder.

Description of Wellhead Marker Buoy

A catamaran type yellow buoy fitted approximately three metres above the water line with a radar reflector and a solar actuated lantern having a flashing yellow light showing the letter U in Morse Code at intervals of thirty seconds. The buoy is marked "Esso Hematite MK015".
