## Commonwealth of Australia Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1967 PROHIBITION OF ENTRY INTO SAFETY ZONE—BREAM PLATFORM

1. Robert Fordham, Minister for Industry, Technology and Resources for the State of Victoria, the Designated Authority in respect of the area specified as being adjacent to the State of Victoria, under the provisions of section 119 of the Act hereby prohibit from entering into or remaining in, except with my consent in writing, the area of the safety zone described hereunder all vessels other than vessels engaged in or in connection with petroleum exploration operations or operations for the recovery of petroleum authorised by me in the area concerned.

Description of Area of Safety Zone

The area which extends to a distance of five hundred metres measured from each point of the structure known as the Bream Platform situated at or about the point of Latitude 38 deg. 30 min. 4-9 sec. south, Longitude 147 deg. 46 min. 15-5 sec. east.
